Average Seasonal Temperatures\*

JULY: High 17C / Low 7C

AUGUST: High 16C / Low 7C

SEPTEMBER: High 9C / Low 3C

OCTOBER: High 1C / Low - 4C

NOVEMBER: High -9C / Low -16C
